It's that time of year again! I'm a little late getting this out. The Plentywood 51th Annual Bazaar will be held Sat. Nov. 11 at the Plentywood Civic Center 10am-4pm.

Your booth space is approx. 8'x7'. This includes an 8ft table. If you do not need a table please let me know so someone else can use. Cottage rules apply to any food sales. You can contact the county sanitarian Cam Ship <u>cshipp coenv@nemont.net</u> if you have further questions.

Set up will be 8:00-10:00 am Saturday morning. If you need to set up anything Friday night, PLEASE contact me ahead of time. You may set up Friday night 7-9 pm. The sale hours are 10:00am to 4:00pm. **PLEASE NO EARLY SALES before 10:00.** <u>There has been a problem in the past of dismantling before</u> <u>the show hours were up.</u> <u>Please no early dismantling</u>. Please do follow this rule. There have been a couple of exceptions, but they were cleared through me before dismantling. We advertise these hours and expect you to abide. No smoking will be allowed in any exhibit room. Lunch will be available.

Spaces are \$25.00 for center and \$35.00 for a wall space. One table will be provided with each space. The stage is available \$75 and is equivalent to 4 spaces. Payment must be received to confirm the registration. If you do not need the tables, **PLEASE LET ME KNOW!** Spaces are reserved in the order the application arrives with the fees. Wall space and electricity will be available (first requested, first serve basis) but they are limited. All items for sale must be handcrafted or baked by the exhibitors. **NO COMMERCIAL ITEMS** (definition considered for commercial is getting the product from somewhere else and reselling it for profit) if any items are suspected, you may be asked not to display them. If you are unsure, please ask. This became a problem at previous fall shows. I have prided myself in providing a <u>quality-handcrafted</u> show and I would like it to remain that way. I hope those involved will police yourself so to save us both from an uncomfortable situation. All food products should comply with the Montana Cottage laws. If you need more info please let me know. Non-profit organizations are a little different. They must keep a list of the product and who made it. You are welcome to share some of your items on our Facebook page (Plentywood Craft Bazaar) after you have sent in your application to help promote the event.
